RESOLVE

In favor of William N. Bourne.

Resolved, For reasons set forth in the petition of William N. Bourne, that there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth, to said petitioner the sum of sixty-six dollars and seventy-four cents the same being in full for services as fourth lieutenant in Company A, third regiment, first division, Massachusetts Volunteer Militia. Said sum shall be paid out of the Union fund provided in chapter two hundred and sixteen of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-one, and in chapter one hundred and forty-seven of the acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-two.
