### AN ACT

In relation to Banks organized under General Laws.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1 The provisions of the one hundred and eighth  
2 section of the fifty-seventh chapter of the General  
3 Statutes are hereby made applicable to banks organ-  
4 ized under the general banking laws which shall  
5 annul their charters or close their business, and the  
6 auditor shall deliver up the plates and dies of every  
7 such bank to be disposed of by the court named,  
8 and in the manner provided in said section for the  
9 benefit of the bank to which they belong.
