AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Harwich to take Stock in the
Cape Cod Central Railroad.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The town of Harwich, in the county of
2 Barnstable, is hereby authorized to subscribe for and
3 hold shares in the capital stock of the Cape Cod
4 Central Railroad Company to the amount of forty
5 thousand dollars, and to pay for the same out of the
6 treasury of the town, and to hold the same as town
7 property, subject to the disposition of the town for
8 public purposes, in like manner as any other property
9 which it may possess.

1 SECT. 2. The said town of Harwich is hereby
2 authorized to raise, by issuing its bonds, or by loan or
3 tax, any sums of money which may be required to
4 pay its instalments, or its subscription to said stock
5 and interest thereon.
