### R E S O L V E

In favor of the Town of Grafton.

*Resolved*, For reasons set forth in the petition of the selectmen of the town of Grafton, that the secretary of the Commonwealth is hereby authorized and directed to furnish to the clerk of said town complete sets of the Massachusetts Reports, Pickering's Reports, Metcalf's Reports, Cushing's Reports, first and third volumes of Gray's Reports, also one copy of the State Map; also copies of all such books and documents in his office as may heretofore have been furnished by the Commonwealth to clerks of towns; and the secretary is authorized to purchase such of the reports aforesaid as may be necessary to carry into effect this resolve; and the governor is authorized to draw his warrant for the necessary amount.
