AN ACT

To authorize David K. Akin to extend his Wharf in
Yarmouth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—*

1 David K. Akin is hereby authorized to extend his
2 wharf in Bass River, in the town of Yarmouth, a dis-
3 tance not exceeding ten feet, and to lay vessels at the
4 said wharf, and to receive wharfage and dockage
5 therefor: *provided*, that this grant shall not impair
6 the legal rights of any person.
