AN ACT

To incorporate the Hancock Mills.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1 SECT. 1. Erastus B. Bigelow, James L. Little,
2 Benjamin E. Bates, John N. Turner, their associates
3 and successors, are hereby made a corporation, by the
4 name of the Hancock Mills, for the purpose of
5 manufacturing worsted goods, and any fabric or yarn
6 or thread composed wholly or in part of either cotton,
7 wool, flax, silk, hemp, or jute, and the machinery
8 therefor, in the town of Holyoke, in the county of
9 Hampden; and for this purpose, shall have all the
10 powers and privileges, and be subject to all duties,
11 restrictions and liabilities set forth in the sixtieth and
12 sixty-eighth chapters of the General Statutes, and the
13 two hundred and eighteenth chapter of the acts of

14 the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two,
15 and all general acts passed after the enactment of the
16 General Statutes relating to manufacturing corpo-
17 rations.

1 SECT. 2. The said corporation may hold, for the
2 purposes aforesaid, real estate to the amount of five
3 hundred thousand dollars; and the whole capital
4 stock of said corporation shall not exceed one million
5 five hundred thousand dollars; and no shares of said
6 corporation shall be issued for a less sum, to be
7 actually paid in on each, than the par value of the
8 shares which shall first be issued.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its passage.
