AN ACT

Concerning the re-location of Streets and Ways in the  
City of Springfield.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1. When the city council of the city of  
2 Springfield deem it necessary to locate anew a street  
3 or way in said city, either for the purpose of estab-  
4 lishing the boundary lines of such street or way,  
5 erecting monuments thereon or of making alterations  
6 in the course or width thereof, they may so locate  
7 such street or way, giving notice, and proceeding in  
8 the manner prescribed by law for laying out and  
9 establishing streets or ways in said city.

1    SECT. 2. Any person sustaining damages in his  
2 property by the location of a street or way, as pro-

3 vided in the preceding section, shall have his com-  
4 pensation ascertained and paid in accordance with  
5 the provisions of the General Statutes in respect to  
6 the laying out, altering and discontinuing of streets  
7 and ways.
