AN ACT

In addition to an Act to authorize the Dorchester and Milton Branch Railroad Company to extend its Railroad.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 The time for locating and constructing the exten-
2 sion of the Dorchester and Milton Branch Railroad,
3 as authorized by the fifty-first chapter of the acts of
4 the year eighteen hundred and sixty-one, is hereby
5 extended two years beyond the time designated in
6 said act.
