R E S O L V E

On the Petition of the Salem Savings Bank.

Resolved, For reasons set forth in its petition, that the Salem Savings Bank be authorized to take and keep on deposit the annuity bequeathed to the trustees of the Salem Savings Bank, in trust, under the will of Thomas F. Odell, and any sum of money which may be taken in compounding said annuity, and hold the same, and the income and interest which may accrue thereon, so long as the supreme judicial court shall direct.
