### AN ACT

In relation to Voting by Proxy in Cemetery Corporations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1. The provisions relating to voting by  
2 proxy, contained in section seven of chapter sixty  
3 of the General Statutes, shall apply to cemetery  
4 corporations.

1    SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
