In favor of the District of Marshpee.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth, to the present treasurer of the district of Marshpee, the sum of two hundred eighty-three forty one-hundredths dollars, in full payment for all claims of said treasurer for aid furnished to Indians and people of color in the district of Marshpee, during the year eighteen hundred and sixty-five.
