### AN ACT

To incorporate the Boston Pilots' Relief Society.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1   SECT. 1. William C. Fowler, Abel T. Hayden,  
2 John McField, John Low, and their associates and  
3 successors, are hereby made a corporation, for the  
4 purpose of furnishing aid and relief to the pilots of  
5 Boston and their families, as occasion may require,  
6 with all the rights and privileges, and subject to all  
7 the duties, restrictions and liabilities set forth in the  
8 general laws which now are, or may hereafter be in  
9 force relating to such corporations.

1   SECT. 2. The said corporation may hold real and  
2 personal estate to an amount not exceeding one  
3 hundred thousand dollars.

1    SECT. 3. The officers of this corporation shall be  
2 chosen annually.

1    SECT. 4. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
