In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-Six.

---

### AN ACT

To provide for the payment of the Militia for services performed at the Annual Inspection in May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1. All officers and soldiers of the Massa-  
2 chusetts volunteer militia who (A) in May, in the  
3 year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, per-  
4 formed the duty required by the first clause of section

5 one hundred, chapter two hundred and thirty-eight  
6 of the acts of the year one thousand eight hundred  
7 and sixty-four, (B) shall receive a compensation  
8 therefor, at the rates provided for "fall encampment,"  
9 in section one hundred and forty-five of the same  
10 act. (C.)

1    SECT. 2. Returns to the adjutant-general of the  
2 performance of the said duty, and the mode of pay-  
3 ment for the same, shall be made in the manner now  
4 prescribed by law for May inspection.

1    SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.

SENATE, March 6, 1866.

Passed to be engrossed in concurrence with the following amendment, to wit:—At (A) section one, strike out from (A) to (B), and insert as follows:—

1 "on the first Wednesday in May, in the year eighteen  
2 hundred and sixty-five, paraded by companies for  
3 inspection, company drill, manœuvre, and did actually  
4 perform the duty of inspection, company drill, and  
5 manœuvre."

At (C) insert as follows:—

1 *provided*, that no compensation shall be paid to any  
2 able-bodied officer or soldier, who, at his own request,  
3 shall be discharged from service in the volunteer  
4 militia previous to January first, in the year one  
5 thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven.
