### AN ACT

To authorize David Smith to build a Wharf in Provincetown.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1   SECT. 1. David Smith, owner of land and flats in  
2 Provincetown, is hereby authorized to build and  
3 maintain a wharf in the harbor of Provincetown,  
4 adjacent to his land aforesaid, and extending to low  
5 water mark in said harbor, with a right to lay vessels  
6 at the end and sides of said wharf, and receive wharf-  
7 age and dockage therefor: *provided, however,* that said  
8 wharf shall be built under the direction of the harbor  
9 commissioners, and if a commissioners' line shall be  
10 hereafter duly established in said harbor, said wharf  
11 shall not be maintained beyond such line; and,

12 *provided, also*, that this grant shall in no wise impair  
13 the legal rights of any person.

1     SECT. 2.   This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
