AN ACT

Relative to the appointment of an Insurance Commissioner.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The governor, by and with the advice and
2 consent of the council, shall appoint some suitable
3 person to be insurance commissioner, who shall, unless
4 sooner removed by the governor, hold his office for
5 the term of three years from the date of his commis-
6 sion and until his successor is appointed and qualified.

1 SECT. 2. The insurance commissioner appointed
2 under this act, shall have all the powers and discharge
3 and perform all the duties, now by law vested in and
4 to be performed by the present board of insurance
5 commissioners. He shall receive an annual salary of

6 two thousand dollars, which shall be in full payment
7 for his services. He may appoint a clerk who shall
8 receive an annual salary of one thousand dollars, both
9 of which salaries shall be paid quarterly out of the
10 treasury of the Commonwealth.

1 SECT. 3. The present board of insurance commis-
2 sioners is hereby abolished.

1 SECT. 4. This act shall take effect on the first day
2 day of July next.
