## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-  
Six.

### AN ACT

In relation to an Assistant Attorney-General.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1. The attorney-general is authorized to  
2    appoint an assistant, who at his request and under his  
3    direction shall aid the attorney-general in the per-  
4    formance of his official duties.

1    SECT. 2. Said assistant attorney-general shall  
2    receive for his services an annual salary of  
3    hundred dollars from the treasury of the Common-  
4    wealth.

1    SECT. 3. All acts authorizing the attorney-general  
2    to employ clerical assistance, and in relation to the  
3    clerk of the attorney-general are hereby repealed.

1    SECT. 4. This act shall take effect upon its  
2    passage.
