AN ACT

To establish the Salary of the Third Clerk in the Office of the Secretary of the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the third clerk in
2 the office of the secretary of the Commonwealth,
3 beginning with the first day of January in the
4 year eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, shall be
5 fifteen hundred dollars per annum, and at the
6 same rate for any portion of a year.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
