## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-seven.

### AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Improvement of the South Boston Flats and for the Prison and Hospital Loan Sinking Fund.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The sums hereinafter mentioned are appropri-  
2 ated, to be paid out of the treasury of the Com-  
3 monwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the  
4 purposes herein specified, to wit:—

5 For the Commonwealth's flats improvement  
6 fund, for the purpose of improving the Common-  
7 wealth's flats at South Boston, as authorized by  
8 chapter forty-six of the resolves of eighteen hun-  
9 dred and eighty-six, a sum not exceeding seventy-  
10 five thousand dollars.

11 For the prison and hospital loan sinking  
12 fund, as authorized by section thirty-six, chapter  
13 two hundred and fifty-five of the acts of the year  
14 eighteen hundred and eighty-four, the sum of  
15 sixty thousand dollars.
