AN ACT

To repeal Section Twenty-four of Chapter One Hundred and Fifty-two of the Public Statutes relating to the Holding of the Terms of the Superior Court for Criminal Business.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
