AN ACT

To amend Section Fifty-two of Chapter Twenty-seven of the Public Statutes relative to the Qualification of Voters in Town Affairs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section fifty-two of chapter twen-
2 ty-seven of the Public Statutes is hereby amended
3 by inserting in the sixth line of said section, after
4 the word "affairs," these words: "and who has
5 been duly registered as a voter in said town."

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
