AN ACT

Relating to the trapping or snaring of Ruffed Grouse,
Hares or Rabbits.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The provisions of section six of chapter two
2 hundred and seventy-six of the acts of eighteen
3 hundred and eighty-six shall not apply to the
4 trapping or snaring of ruffed grouse (commonly
5 called partridge), hares or rabbits by an owner of
6 land upon his land, or by a member of the family
7 of such owner if authorized by such owner,
8 between the first day of October and the first
9 day of January.
