### RESOLVE

In favor of Fanny L. Nye.

1   *Resolved*, That Fanny L. Nye, wife of John W. Nye,  
2 now insane and confined in the Northampton Lunatic  
3 Asylum, who was a member of Company A, tenth regi-  
4 ment Massachusetts volunteers, and by transfer of the  
5 thirty-seventh and twentieth regiments Massachusetts  
6 volunteers, during the war of the Rebellion, shall be  
7 eligible to receive State aid under the provisions, rules  
8 and limitations of chapter thirty of the Public Statutes  
9 in the same manner and to the same extent that she  
10 would be entitled if her husband was in receipt of a pen-  
11 sion from the United States and was otherwise entitled  
12 to State aid.
