AN ACT

To include the Town of East Bridgewater within the
Judicial District of the Police Court of Brockton.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of East Bridgewater
2 is hereby annexed to and made a part of the
3 judicial district under the jurisdiction of the police
4 court of the city of Brockton: *provided, however,*
5 that nothing in this act shall affect any suit or
6 other proceeding begun and pending at the time
7 of its taking effect.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon the
2 first day of July, eighteen hundred and eighty-
3 seven.
