AN ACT

To provide for the Release from County Prisons of Prisoners transferred thereto from the Massachusetts Reformatory.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The commissioners of prisons
2 shall have solely the same right and authority to
3 release from a jail or house of correction any
4 prisoner who has been or may hereafter be
5 transferred thereto from the Massachusetts Re-
6 formatory, and to return him to said jail or house
7 of correction, which they would have had to
8 release him from said reformatory, and to return
9 him thereto, if he had not been so transferred.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
