RESOLVE

Providing for the Purchase of Uniforms, Equipments and  
Military Supplies for the Volunteer Militia.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding  
3 seventy-eight thousand dollars, to be expended by the  
4 quartermaster-general, under the direction of the gov-  
5 ernor and commander-in-chief, for the purchase of  
6 uniforms, equipments and supplies for the volunteer  
7 militia. No part of this sum shall be expended unless  
8 contracts can be made satisfactory to the commander-in-  
9 chief to furnish such uniforms, equipments and supplies  
10 and for the amount specified in this resolve.
