In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-seven.

RESOLVE

Providing for Additional Fire Protection, a Carriage House, and certain other Improvements at the Westborough Insane Hospital.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding forty-
3 nine thousand eight hundred and twenty-five dollars, to
4 be expended at the Westborough Insane Hospital at
5 Westborough, under the direction of the trustees, for the
6 following purposes, to wit: For the purpose of furnishing
7 proper drainage for the buildings, more perfect ventila-
8 tion, additional heating apparatus, the purchase of land
9 for a sewer field and the proper distribution of the
10 sewage, a sum not exceeding thirty thousand dollars; for
11 new pipe for fire service, for a fire-engine, hose and hose
12 carriage, a sum not exceeding three thousand dollars; for
13 a coal shed, horses, cows and oxen, hay-ricks and row-
14 boats, a sum not exceeding three thousand two hundred
15 and seventy-five dollars; for an ice house, furnishing two
16 cottages for help, furnishing the attic, and for blinds and

17 painting, a sum not exceeding two thousand nine hundred
18 dollars ; for reconstructing roof, for catches on roof for
19 snow and ice, a sum not exceeding three thousand dollars ;
20 for carriage house and vegetable cellar, for carriages for
21 patients and officers, a sum not exceeding five thousand
22 dollars ; for concreting barn cellar, for a coal cellar and
23 for a dead-house, a sum not exceeding one thousand six
24 hundred and fifty dollars ; and for a medical library and
25 instruments, and a library for the use of patients, a sum
26 not exceeding one thousand dollars : *provided*, that if in
27 the judgment of the trustees a larger sum is needed for
28 the purposes of drainage, heating, ventilation and sewage
29 disposal than is herein specified, any other sums herein
30 appropriated may be used for said purposes.
