

HOUSE No. 521.

[Mr. Clark of Lynn moves to substitute this order for the bill which is printed as House, No. 519.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Ordered, That a joint special committee be appointed to consist of five members on the part of the House of Representatives, with such members as the Senate may join, to sit during the recess of the Legislature and consider plans for additional accommodations for the State government.

Said committee shall hear such evidence as may be submitted after public notice, and is authorized to solicit preliminary architectural plans, and shall report in print to the next General Court, not later than February 1, 1888, the result of its inquiry, with recommendations in reference thereto.

Said committee is authorized to employ a stenographer if found necessary, and shall be provided with a room at the State House and all necessary stationery and postage by the Sergeant-at-Arms.

The members of said committee shall be paid such compensation as may be determined by the Governor and Council.
