AN ACT

To authorize the New England Shoe and Leather Association to hold Additional Real and Personal Property.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section two of chapter twelve of
2 the acts of the year eighteen hundred seventy-
3 one is hereby amended to read as follows: The
4 New England Shoe and Leather Association may
5 hold real and personal estate to an amount not
6 exceeding five hundred thousand dollars, to be
7 devoted exclusively to the purposes of said cor-
8 poration.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
