AN ACT

To establish the Salary of the Clerk of the Police Court of Springfield.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the clerk of the
2 police court of Springfield shall be fourteen hun-
3 dred dollars a year, from the first day of January,
4 A.D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-
5 nine.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
