AN ACT

To amend Chapter Sixty - Eight of the Public Statutes relating to Licenses for Hawkers and Peddlers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section nine of chapter sixty-
2 eight of the Public Statutes is hereby repealed
3 and the following is substituted therefor.

4 The Secretary of the Commonwealth may
5 grant a special state or county license to any
6 honorably discharged soldier or sailor belonging
7 to this Commonwealth without the payment of
8 any sum therefor.
