In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-nine.

AN ACT

To fix the Penalties for Violations of the Liquor
Laws.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section eighteen of chapter one hun-
2 dred of the Public Statutes is hereby amended
3 by striking out the word "or" in the third line
4 and substituting therefor the word "and," and by
5 striking out in the fourth line the words "or by
6 both such fine and imprisonment," so that said
7 section shall read as follows: *Sect. 18.* Whoever
8 violates any provision of his license or of this
9 chapter shall be punished by fine of not less than
10 fifty nor more than five hundred dollars, and

11 imprisonment for not less than one nor more than
12 six months. A licensed person who violates any
13 provision of his license shall, in addition to said
14 penalties, forfeit his license, and be disqualified
15 to hold a license for the period of one year after
16 his conviction; but this section, so far as forfeit-
17 ure of licenses is concerned, shall not apply to
18 licenses of the sixth class; and, if the licensee is
19 the owner of said premises, no license shall be
20 exercised on the premises described in the for-
21 feited license during the residue of the term
22 thereof.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
