### AN ACT

Requiring Savings Banks and Institutions for Savings to make an Accurate Trial Balance of their Depositors' Ledgers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Every savings bank and institu-  
2 tion for savings shall, as often as once in each of  
3 its fiscal years, make an accurate trial balance of  
4 its depositors' ledgers.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
