### AN ACT

To authorize the City of Quincy to pay Certain  
Engineers and Volunteer Firemen.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Quincy is hereby  
2 authorized to raise by taxation a sum of money  
3 not exceeding twenty-seven hundred and thirty  
4 dollars, and to appropriate the same to the pay-  
5 ment of the engineers and volunteer firemen for  
6 services rendered and to be rendered during the  
7 year ending May first in the year one thousand  
8 eight hundred and eighty-nine: *provided*, the  
9 same be appropriated by a two-thirds vote of the  
10 members of the city council of said city present  
11 and voting.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
