AN ACT

To incorporate the Sagamore Cemetery Association.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Hiram Crowell, Lafayette Gibbs,
2 Edwin C. Swift, Benjamin B. Abbe, Nathan Nye,
3 William R. Gibbs, Charles H. Burgess, second, and
4 Isaac N. Keith, their associates and successors,
5 are hereby made a corporation by the name of
6 the Sagamore Cemetery Association, for the pur-
7 pose of perfecting, controlling and improving the
8 grounds set apart, used and known as the "cem-
9 etery" in the village of Sagamore in the town of
10 Bourne. Said corporation shall have all the pow-
11 ers, and be subject to all the duties, restrictions
12 and liabilities set forth in all general laws which

13 now are or hereafter may be in force applicable
14 to such corporations, except as is otherwise pro-
15 vided in this act.

1 SECT. 2. The said corporation may take and
2 hold the real estate known as the Sagamore Cem-
3 etery lot situate in that part of the town of
4 Bourne called Sagamore.

1 SECT. 3. The said corporation may acquire by
2 gift, devise or purchase, and hold in fee simple, so
3 much real estate in the village of Sagamore in
4 the town of Bourne, and may also hold so much
5 personal property, as may be necessary for the
6 objects connected with and appropriate to the
7 purposes of said corporation.

1 SECT. 4. Any person claiming to be ag-
2 grieved by the provisions of this act may at any
3 time within one year after this act takes effect
4 apply by petition to the superior court for the
5 county of Barnstable, and his damages, if any,
6 shall be assessed and determined by and under
7 the direction of said court, and shall be paid by
8 said Sagamore Cemetery Association.

1 SECT. 5. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
