AN ACT

To authorize Manufacturing Corporations to support Free Beds in Hospitals for the use of their employees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any manufacturing corporation may, by a
2 majority of the stock represented at a meeting
3 of the stockholders thereof, vote a total sum not
4 exceeding five thousand dollars or an annual
5 sum not exceeding five hundred dollars for the
6 support of free beds in one or more hospitals in
7 this Commonwealth for the use of its employes.
