AN ACT

Relating to Clerical Assistance in the Office of the Register of Probate and Insolvency in Bristol County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The register of probate and in-
2 solvency for the county of Bristol shall be al-
3 lowed annually in addition to the amount now
4 allowed by law, a sum not exceeding four hun-
5 dred dollars, for clerical assistance actually per-
6 formed, to be paid from the treasury of the
7 Commonwealth upon the official certificate of the
8 judge of probate and insolvency for said county.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
