### AN ACT

To establish the Salary of the Second Assistant Clerk of the Municipal Court for Civil Business of the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the second assist-  
2 ant clerk of the municipal court for civil business  
3 of the city of Boston shall be two thousand dol-  
4 lars a year from the first day of March, A.D.  
5 eighteen hundred and eighty-nine.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
