## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-nine.

### AN ACT

To regulate the Manner of Voting on Appropriations  
at Town Meetings.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows.*

1 SECTION 1. At all town-meetings where appro-  
2 priations and expenditures are to be acted upon,  
3 the vote in any appropriation on expenditure  
4 shall be taken by ballot (yes or no) and use of  
5 check-list, if ten or more legal voters then and  
6 there request the same.

1 SECT. 2. All towns shall provide check-lists  
2 and ballots to meet the requirements of this act.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
