AN ACT

To change the Name of the Christian Union Church
of Stoneham.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The name of the Christian Union
2 church, a religious society located at Stoneham,
3 is hereby changed to the first Unitarian church
4 of Stoneham.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
