## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-nine.

### AN ACT

Relating to the Payment of County Taxes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The respective sums apportioned to, and  
2 assessed upon, the several cities and towns of the  
3 Commonwealth for county taxes, shall be col-  
4 lected and paid into their respective city and town  
5 treasuries, in like manner as the state tax is now  
6 collected and paid; and the county commission-  
7 ers in their warrants shall require the selectmen  
8 or assessors of said cities and towns to pay or  
9 issue severally their warrant or warrants requir-  
10 ing the treasurers of their respective cities and  
11 towns to pay to the treasurers of their several  
12 counties the sums apportioned to said cities and  
13 towns, as aforesaid, at such times as shall be  
14 fixed and prescribed by said county commission-  
15 ers of the several counties in their said warrants.
