AN ACT

To authorize the refunding to James Donoghue of Money paid by him as Bondsman for Thomas F. Donoghue, from the Treasury of the County of Plymouth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the
2 county of Plymouth may pay to James Donoghue
3 of Abington, in said county, a sum not exceeding
4 six hundred dollars as amends to him for money
5 paid by him into the treasury of said county as
6 bondsman of Thomas F. Donoghue.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
