### AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Plymouth to raise Money for the Celebration of the Completion of the National Monument to the Pilgrims in Plymouth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Plymouth is author-  
2 ized to raise by taxation a sum of money not  
3 exceeding one-thirtieth of one per centum of the  
4 assessed valuation of said town in the year one  
5 thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight for the  
6 purpose of celebrating the completion of the  
7 national monument to the Pilgrims in said town.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
