AN ACT

To establish the Salary of the Clerk of the Police Court of Newburyport.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the clerk of the
2 police court of Newburyport shall be eight hun-
3 dred dollars a year, from the first day of April,
4 eighteen hundred and eighty-nine.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
