AN ACT

To abolish Clerks' Term Fees, in the Supreme Judicial and Superior Courts and before County Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows.

1 SECTION 1. The term fees provided by Pub-
2 lic Statutes chapter one hundred and ninety-nine,
3 section four, to be taxed in cases for each term
4 during which an action, complaint or petition is
5 pending in the supreme judicial and superior
6 courts and before county commissioners are
7 hereby abolished, and shall not hereafter be
8 taxed by the clerks of said courts in cases pend-
9 ing prior to the first day of July eighteen hun-
10 dred and eighty-eight.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
