AN ACT

To exempt Certain Property of the First Baptist Society in Methuen from Taxation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All the property both real and
2 personal held by the First Baptist Society in
3 Methuen, which was devised and bequeathed to
4 said society in and by the will of Moses Webster,
5 shall be exempt from taxation.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
