RESOLVE

In favor of Mary Harrington.

1 *Resolved*, That Mary Harrington, mother of Thomas
2 H. Kelly, who served in the United States navy during
3 the war of the rebellion, from and after the first day of
4 April in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, be
5 eligible to receive State aid under the provisions, rules
6 and regulations of chapter thirty of the Public Statutes
7 and chapter thirty-four of the Acts of the year eighteen
8 hundred and eighty-four in the same manner and to the
9 same intent that she would have been entitled had her
10 son served to the credit of this Commonwealth.
