RESOLVE

Providing for Certain Repairs and Improvements at the
State Farm at Bridgewater.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding
3 seventeen thousand and five hundred dollars to be
4 expended at the State farm at Bridgewater, under the
5 direction of the trustees and superintendent, for the fol-
6 lowing purposes, to wit: for the erection of buildings for
7 the storage of ice, a sum not exceeding fifteen hundred
8 dollars; for heating and furnishing the new buildings in
9 process of construction, a sum not exceeding ten
10 thousand dollars; for moving, repairing and building
11 additions to the barn nearest the main buildings, and the
12 erection of a new stable; a sum not exceeding six
13 thousand dollars.
