

AN ACT TO LIMIT THE ASSUMPTION OF RISK BY AN EMPLOYEE OF A RAILROAD CORPORATION. *Chap. 553*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section one hundred and sixty-seven of Part II of chapter four hundred and sixty-three of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and six is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the words:— An employee of a railroad corporation who is injured by any locomotive, car or train by reason of the negligence of any other employee of the corporation shall not be deemed to have assumed the risk of such injury, — so as to read as follows:

— *Section 167.* An employee of a railroad corporation who is injured by any locomotive, car or train which is used contrary to the provisions of sections one hundred and fifty-nine, one hundred and sixty-one, one hundred and sixty-two and one hundred and sixty-three, shall not be deemed to have assumed the risk of such injury, although he continues in the employment of such corporation after the unlawful use of such locomotive, car or train has been brought to his knowledge. An employee of a railroad corporation who is injured by any locomotive, car or train by reason of the negligence of any other employee of the corporation shall not be deemed to have assumed the risk of such injury.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The Milford and Woonsocket Railroad Company may sell and convey its franchises and property to the New England Railroad Company, or its successor, and upon such conveyance the New England Railroad Company, or its successor, shall become possessed of all the franchises and property thereby conveyed, and may hold and use the same in its own name and right subject
