RESOLVE

Providing for Remodelling and Enlarging the State Normal School at Bridgewater, or for the Erection of a New Building.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth, a sum not exceeding one
3 hundred and fifty thousand dollars, to be expended at
4 the State normal school at Bridgewater, under the direc-
5 tion of the State board of education, for the following
6 purposes, to wit: for reconstructing, remodelling and
7 enlarging the school building, or for erecting a new school
8 building, for removing such portions of the old building
9 as may be necessary, for heating, plumbing and venti-
10 lation, for architect's commission and expenses, and for
11 all necessary expenses for furnishing said building for
12 the use of the school: *provided, however*, that no part
13 of the sum herein named shall be expended, until plans
14 shall have been submitted to the governor and council
15 which will satisfy them that the expenditure herein
16 authorized will not exceed the amount stated in this

17 resolve; and *provided, still further*, that no larger sum
18 than seventy-five thousand dollars shall be expended dur-
19 ing the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine.
