RESOLVE

In favor of Simon B. Tuesley.

1 *Resolved*, That Simon B. Tuesley, a citizen of Boston,
2 Massachusetts, who enlisted in the first corps of cadets,
3 Massachusetts Volunteer Militia, June sixth, eighteen
4 hundred and sixty-two, serving until July second, eigh-
5 teen hundred and sixty-two, shall, from and after the first
6 day of June in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine,
7 be eligible to receive state aid under the provisions, rules
8 and limitations of chapter three hundred and one of the
9 acts of the present year, in the same manner and to the
10 same extent that he would have been entitled had he
11 served to the credit of Massachusetts.
